PRESIDENT'S

COLUMN



Jim Rankin

This is my final message to the Topeka Bar, at least in the capacity of President. I leave office this month and turn over the presidency to the capable Laura Graham. Serving as the President of the Topeka Bar has been one of the great honors of my life.

Hopefully, some of you have found my monthly columns of interest. My intention was that each column would be entitled "Defining Liberty," but that plan failed. Nevertheless, the title was meant to encourage reflection on the meaning of the term liberty, as it is used in philosophy, constitutional law, and politics. And, more importantly, how the definition of liberty is impacted by events that have become the history of the United States. Perhaps the same may be said for the phrase "rule of law." The important thing is that our history, since the English colonization of America, has been framed by the ideal of liberty and the rule of law.

Those ideals and the words of our Constitution will inform the Justices of our Supreme Court, both national and state, regardless of who is elected President this November and regardless of who sits on the bench. Therefore, even though the rough and tumble of our democracy is hard to watch, Americans can continue to expect their government, reasonably responsive to the will of majorities, except in cases protected by the Bill of Rights, will, borrowing Abraham Lincoln's phrase of November 19, 1863, "long endure."
