Born in Kansas City, Larry attended Washburn University to earn a Bachelor of Arts in economics *magna cum laude*, followed by his Juris Doctor from the University of Kansas School of Law, where he served as editor of the Law Review.

Larry joined Foulston in 1979, where his interest in farming and ranching made him a natural to lead the firm's agribusiness team for many years, as well as counseling clients on corporate, business, and finance matters.
